# FACULTY DEVELOPMENT programme

## OBJECTIVES

- To create a pool of interested, motivated and trained manpower in areas of Fashion Design, Fashion Technology and Fashion Management at the national level.
- To identify interested, academically inclined alumni and formally equip them for handling positions in the field of fashion education.

## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. The eligibility criteria will be qualifying degree recognised by law in India with a minimum CGPA 6.0 or 60% or equivalent. Industry/Research/Teaching experience will be an added advantage.  
Details of the qualifying degree is as follows:

### Qualifying Degree: Design

- UG/PG Degree in any field of Design – Fashion Space/Accessory Design/Industrial Design/Communication Design/Exhibition Design/Interior Design from CEPT, Ahmedabad/B.Des./M.Des./IDC from IIT's/
- B.F.A./M.F.A.
- M.Sc. (Clothing & Textiles)
- B.Arch./M.Arch.
- (or) Equivalent qualification from an institute of international repute/international university.

### Qualifying Degree: Management

- PG Degree M.F.M. from NIFT
- MBA Marketing/Finance, MBE;
- MA Journalism & Mass Communication;
- B.Tech./M.Tech. Textile Technology
- (or) equivalent qualification from an institute of international repute/international university

### Qualifying Degree: Technology

- UG/PG Degree DFT/MFM from NIFT;
- UG/PG Degree in Design/Technology/Management from an institute of international repute;
- BE/B.Tech./ME/M.Tech. Textile Technology/Information Technology/Leather Technology/Industrial/Production Engineering;
- M.Sc. Clothing & Textiles/Statistics/Operation & Research/MCA/MCM;
- (or) equivalent qualification from an institute of international repute/international university

2. The programme is also offered to NIFT alumni alongwith fresh graduates without work experience with the CGPA of 6.0 or 60% above or equivalent.

## ADMISSION PROCESS

The candidates would be shortlisted based on the Application Forms. For the final selection, the shortlisted candidates would be called for a Personal Interview.

## TIMESCALE

FDP is a one year diploma programme, starting from end of July 2010.

## PROGRAMME DETAILS

### SEMESTER 1

Dates: 26th July - 26th November 2010  
Duration: 16 weeks

Semester 1 will have two components:

- Day activity which is the auditing component and
- Evening activity which is the taught component

### Day Activity

Candidates will audit 3-4 subjects leading to minimum work load of 18 hrs per week under suitable mentor. Candidates will develop the subject files for the subjects audited.

Expected outcome:

Development of course material, lesson plan, presentations etc for the subjects audited, which will serve as teaching aids later on.

Evaluation guideline:

The mentors with the subject experts will evaluate the subject files prepared by the candidates. The candidates will be evaluated on content, innovation and creativity of lesson plan, class hand-outs and classroom presentations.

Credits as per the subjects selected for auditing:  
Minimum of 7

## Evening activity

Candidates will be attending the classes in the evening from 5:30 pm - 8:30 pm for 16 weeks.

Expected outcome:

The taught component of the programme focuses on practical, effective techniques and strategies that would develop the candidate's capabilities as an educationist. It will ensure that the future trainers are skilled and confident in their abilities to train students and serve as informed resources for the organisation.

Evaluation guideline:

Examination will be conducted for the subjects taught.

Credits of evening activity: 15

## WINTER INTERNSHIP IN RELEVANT SECTOR

Dates: 29th Nov. - 17th Dec. 2010  
Duration: 3 weeks

Number of hours of internship: 8 hours per day, 6 days a week (144 hrs)

Evaluation guideline: Documentation & Presentation

Credits for winter internship in relevant sector: 3

### SEMESTER 2

Dates: 10th January - 30th April 2011

Duration: 16 weeks

Semester 2 has only day activity which is divided into two components: auditing component and practical class conducting component.

#### Day Activity

Candidates will audit and conduct classes (under supervision) for 3-4 subjects leading to minimum workload of 18 hrs per week under suitable mentor. Subject experts will audit the classes conducted and formal feedback shall be given to the candidate on the same. Candidates will also be involved in student mentorship, student evaluation juries and subject feedback to the students. Candidates will develop the subject files for the subjects audited.

#### Expected outcome:

Development of course material for the subjects audited and practical experience of conducting classes.

#### Evaluation guideline:

The mentors with the subject experts will examine the subject files prepared by the candidates. The candidates will be evaluated on content, innovation and creativity of lesson plan, class hand-outs and classroom presentations.

There will also be an End term Seminar/Presentation on various subjects covered.

Credits as per the subject selected: Minimum of 7

The candidates will be expected to clear with a minimum of 7.0 CGPA in overall evaluation.

Candidates (General/OBC Category) using the downloaded Application Form are required to submit a Demand Draft of Rs.2250/- alongwith Application Form.
