ABOUT THE INSTITUTE

National Institute of Fashion Technology (NIFT) is a premier institute under the aegis of the Ministry of Textiles, Government of India imparting education in the field of Fashion Design, Technology, and Management. The institute has been given the status of an Institute of excellence and thus permitted to award degrees to its students by an Act of Parliament. NIFT Bengaluru operates at its own campus at No. 21, 16th Cross, 27th Main Road, Sector – 1, HSR Layout, Bengaluru – 560 102.

NIFT's requirements

- 1. Bidder will enclose a Demand Draft of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees: Twenty thousand Only) favouring NIFT, payable at Bengaluru as EMD for the Cafeteria Service and the same will be refunded to the unsuccessful bidders within a reasonable time after finalization of the contract.
- 2. The Tender document can be downloaded from the NIFT, Bengaluru website at free cost (www.nift.ac.in/bengaluru/tenders)
- 3. Period of Contract for One year from the date of Agreement, however, the contract can be further renewed for one year each time and a maximum of up to two more years on mutually agreed terms & conditions depending upon satisfactory services (including the first year).
- Tender form is available for sale and downloads from 10.03.2022 to 30.03.2022 up to 02.30 pm.
- Closing Date & Time of submission: 30.03.2022 up to 03.00 pm.
- Date & Time of opening the Tender: 30.03.2022 at 03.30 pm.
- Filled in a tender to be dropped in the tender box in the Administration Section, NIFT, Bengaluru or to be forwarded by post on or before the due date. NIFT, Bengaluru will not be responsible for delays in transit or loss.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The contract will be awarded to the highest maintenance charges quoted and experience in the same business.
- 2. The maintenance charges will be increased by 10% after the completion of a year.
- 3. The contract for the cafeteria shall remain valid initially for a period of one year.
- 4. The contract period is subject to renewal by the Institute on satisfactory performance and on mutually agreed terms and conditions for a further period of one year and a maximum period of two years or till such time as mutually agreed to.

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- 5. The bidder must be in a business of cafeteria and running a cafeteria in a reputed organization / educational institute having at least three years of experience in the cafeteria.
- 6. All pages of the Tender Document must be signed by the authorized signatory and must clearly write his/her name and also specify the capacity in which signing and sealed with the stamp of the bidding firm as token of having accepted all the Terms and Conditions of this Tender.
- 7. Tender shall be submitted in NIFT's official tender form only. If submitted in any other manner, the same shall be summarily rejected. No bidder shall be issued more than one Tender Form.
- 8. No paper shall be removed from the Tender Document.
- 9. The name and address of the bidder shall be clearly written in the space provided for the purpose and no over-writing, correction; insertion shall be permitted in any part of the tender unless duly countersigned by the bidder. The tender should be filled in and submitted strictly in accordance with the instructions contained herein, otherwise, the Tender is liable to be rejected.
- 10. The Institute reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason.
- 11. Before submitting the filled-in Tender Document to the Institute, the bidders may seek clarification(s), if any, from Administrative Department on Tel. No. 080-2255 2550 55 **OR** in person by visiting the Institute during working hours by taking prior appointments.
- 12. The Institute reserves the right to change any condition of the tender before the opening of the Technical Bids.
- 13. NIFT will offer space measuring 10 ft X 10 ft for setting up a stall within campus situated at HSR Layout Bengaluru.
- 14. Basic seating/chairs may be planned by the contractor at their own cost.
- 15. NIFT will not bear the expenditure for the setting-up of stall/infrastructure.
- 16. The contractor must keep the surroundings clean, neat and create a good ambiance in consultation with the NIFT authority.
- 17. The Contractor shall ensure proper discipline among his/her workers and further ensure that they do not indulge in any unlawful activity.
- 18. Employment of child labour is strictly prohibited under the law. Therefore, the Contractor will not employ any child labour.
- 19. The Contractor shall be responsible for timely payment of wages to his/her workers as per the Minimum Wages Act.
- 20. The contractor should attach a Menu/items List and price list of Coffee, Tea, Snacks with the tender document, with quantity (Ml/qty in pieces/Nos)
- 21. This cafeteria/kiosk is in addition to the canteen existing canteen. Menu to be for a quick grab and bite and not full fledge cooking.

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- 22. The Contractor shall get the prices of all items approved by the Institute and no changes, whatsoever shall be made without the prior written approval of the Institute. The contractor should also be prepared to include additional items in the menu at the request of competent authority.
- 23. The Contractor will open the cafeteria during late hours and on Saturdays/Sundays, including other holidays, according to the requirement of NIFT and the hostellers/staff/faculty.
- 24. The contractor shall be responsible for cleaning and removing garbage from the premises.
- 25. The Contractor shall not appoint any sub-contractor to carry out his obligations under the contract.
- 26. The Contract can be terminated by either party, i.e., NIFT or the Contractor, after giving two months' notice to the other party extendable by mutual agreement till alternate arrangements are made. However, NIFT reserves the right to terminate the contract without giving any notice in case the Contractor commits a breach of any of the terms of the contract. NIFT's decision in such a situation shall be final and shall be accepted by the Contractor without any objection or resistance.
- 27. Storing/supply/sale and consumption of drugs, alcoholic drinks, cigarettes, or any other items of intoxication are strictly prohibited on the Institute's campus. Any breach of such restrictions by the Contractor will attract deterrent action against the Contractor as per statutory norms.
- 28. NIFT will provide a subsidy of 50% on rentals during holidays on the campus if the holiday exceeds 15 days.
- 29. Please read the Terms & Conditions carefully before filling up the document. Incomplete Tender Documents will be rejected.
- 30. Force Majeure clause will be applicable as per the guidelines of the Government of India.
- 31. Necessary health and food safety organization certificate from local authorities. The site is subject to inspection and supervision of concerned officials.

SECURITY DEPOSIT

- 32. The contractor shall be required to deposit 5 months of maintenance charges as quoted in the bid as a security deposit immediately on acceptance of Work Order in the form of a demand draft of nationalized bank/scheduled bank, in an acceptable form in favour of NIFT, payable at Bengaluru. No interest shall be paid on such security deposit, which shall remain with the Institute during the continuance of the contract and it shall be released only two months after the expiry or termination of the contract, subject to clearance of all dues by the contractor.
- 33. If the Contract is terminated by the Contractor without giving a stipulated period of notice or fails to observe the terms & conditions of the Tender, the Security Deposit will be forfeited without prejudice to the NIFT Management's right to proceed against the contractor for any additional damages that the Institute suffers as a result of the breach of the aforesaid terms and conditions.



MAINTENANCE CHARGES, ELECTRICITY AND WATER CHARGES

- 34. The Contractor shall have to pay maintenance charges for utilization of space at the NIFT Bengaluru campus as quoted in the tender on or before the 10th of every month towards maintenance charges with applicable GST to the institute through Demand Draft in favour of NIFT Bengaluru/online transfer.
- 35. The contractor will be required to pay the Institute electricity charges on an actual basis, for which sub-meters shall be provided. Actual consumption of the electricity charges will be paid on or before the 10th of every month on a monthly meter reading basis separately by the Contractor.
- 36. No separate water charges will be charged by the institute.

TERMINATION OF THE CONTRACT

- 37. NIFT reserves the right to terminate the contract without giving any notice in case the Contractor commits a breach of any of the terms of the contract. NIFT's decision in such a situation shall be final and shall be accepted by the Contractor without any objection or resistance. The Contract can be terminated by either party, after giving two months' notice. This contract will be extendable by mutual agreement till alternate arrangements are made.
- 38. The Contractor should hand over the space in the same condition as it was given to them at the time of occupation and if any damage is found, the charges should be recovered from the contractor.

PENALTY

- 39. The Institute reserves the right to impose a penalty (to be decided by the NIFT authorities) on the Contractor for any serious lapse in maintaining the quality and the services willfully or otherwise by the Contractor or his staff or for any adulteration and violation of terms and condition of the contract/work order and agreement.
- 40. If the Institute is not satisfied with the quality of eatables served, services provided or behavior of the contractor or his/her employees, the Contractor will be served 24 hours' notice to improve or rectify the defect(s), failing which the NIFT will be at liberty to take appropriate necessary steps as deemed fit.
- 41. Notwithstanding any other court or courts having jurisdiction to decide the question(s) forming the subject matter of the reference if the same had been the subject matter of the suit, any and all actions and proceedings arising out of or relating to the contract (including any arbitration in terms thereof) shall lie only in the court of competent civil jurisdiction in this behalf at Bengaluru and only the said courts shall have jurisdiction to entertain and try such action(s) and/or proceedings to the exclusion of all the other courts.
