


Students gain hands on learning experience under the guidance of renowned master craftsmen and explore various surface

   and demand draft to produce at the time of interview.

All the candidates will have to appear for personal interview at NIFT Bhopal Centre. The interview will be designed to test the knowledge, skill and aptitude of the candidates. The date of interview will be intimated by NIFT Bhopal. The list of selected candidates will be displayed at NIFT Bhopal Centre and on NIFT Website within a week time.


