Bhopal has many lavish shopping malls. DB City Mall ranks among the top 10 malls in India. Bhopal is a paradise for fast-food lovers, and had some delicious fast-food joints.

Bhopal's Rani Kamalapati railway station (formerly known as Habibganj railway station) was the first ISO-certified railway station in the country.

Bhopal has an amazing blend of religions. Some of the important holy places in bhopal are: Birla Mandir, Manuabhan Tekri, Jama-Masjid, Moti Masjid etc. It is the fusion of peace, greenery, development, liveliness, religiosity, and many more aspects.

How to reach NIFT Bhopal


Bhopal has fairly good connectivity with all major cities.

One can reach Bhopal city by any of the following means:


If you are reaching Bhopal by train:

From Rani Kamalapati railway station (formerly known as Habibganj railway station) (station code: RKMP) to NIFT Bhopal – around 25 KM.

One can take auto, taxi, etc and it takes around 50 min to 1 Hour, costing around Rs 500/-.




From Bhopal Junction railway station (station code: BPL) to NIFT Bhopal – around 20 KM. One can take auto, taxi, etc and it takes around 40-45 min, costing around Rs 420/-.



If you are reaching Bhopal by air:

From Raja Bhoj International Airport to NIFT Bhopal – around 10 KM.

One can take auto, taxi, etc and it takes around 15-20 min, costing around Rs 300/-.



Weather at Bhopal

The weather in Bhopal during summer from March to May is hot and humid. July and August receive the maximum rainfall. October and November are pleasant months in terms of weather in Bhopal. Bhopal winter starts in December and ends in February. January is the peak winter month.
