It is to inform that, the Telangana State Government has introduced 2023-24 Online submission of SC/ST/BC/EBC/Minority/Disabled students Scholarship applications through e-pass website and the last date for submitting online application is 31<sup>st</sup> December,2023. SC/ST students whose parental income is 2.00 Lakhs or below; BC/EBC/Minority Students whose parental income is Rs.1.50 lakhs or below for Rural Areas and Rs. 2.00 Lakhs or below for Urban Areas; Disabled Welfare Students whose parental income is Rs.1.00 Lakh or below and whose attendance is minimum 75% at the end of each quarter are eligible for the scholarship. All the departments are requested to intimate the students to apply online scholarship in the Telangana scholarship portal www.telanganaepass.cgg.gov.in.

All CC's are requested to give wide publicity among all the eligible students of Telangana State (Juniors & Seniors) and inform them to apply online scholarship for the year 2023-24 and submit hardcopies along with supporting documents to Academic Section on or before 5<sup>th</sup> January,2024, so as to enable us to forward the same to the District Welfare Offices in Telangana State.

While applying ONLINE scholarship the following are the mandatory documents for registration process:

- S.S.C & Intermediate Certificate,
- 2. Aadhaar Card,
- 3. Caste Certificate obtained from Meeseva Centre.
- 4. Income Certificate obtained from Meeseva Centre after 1st April'2023.
- 5. Bank Account Pass Book in any of the Nationalized Bank (showing student Name, Bank Account No. and IFSC code of the Bank Branch) Bank Account is not required for Economically Backward Class (EBC) students.
- Student valid Mobile Number & Email-ID.
- 7. Bonafide Certificate for the last seven consecutive years of study.
- 8. Common Entrance Test allotment order for CET courses.
- 9. Latest Passport size photograph.
- 10. Transfer Certificate (for fresher's only),
- 11. Admission Fee Receipt.
