For the posts mentioned at 01,02 & 04, the eligible candidates shall appear for skill test first. The skill test shall be of qualifying nature only. Thereafter, only those applicants who qualify the skill test shall be allowed to appear in written test. The final selection shall be made on written test only.

In case of the post of Junior Assistant, weightage of 05 points shall be granted in final selection to applicants having diploma/degree in computers. For above purpose only diploma awarded by institutions recognized by Govt shall be admissible. In case of full-time diploma, the minimum duration shall be 1 year while in case of part time, the minimum duration shall be 2 years. Alternatively, Govt recognized degrees in computer application shall also be accepted. Applicants possessing diploma/degree as explained above shall be given 5 marks as preferential weightage in the final Selection. Accordingly, the written test for the post of Junior Assistant shall have an overall weightage of 95 marks only.

- 1. Skill Test Qualifying Test only; it shall have no weightage in the final selection.

Typing speed of at least 40 wpm in English/Hindi on Desktops
